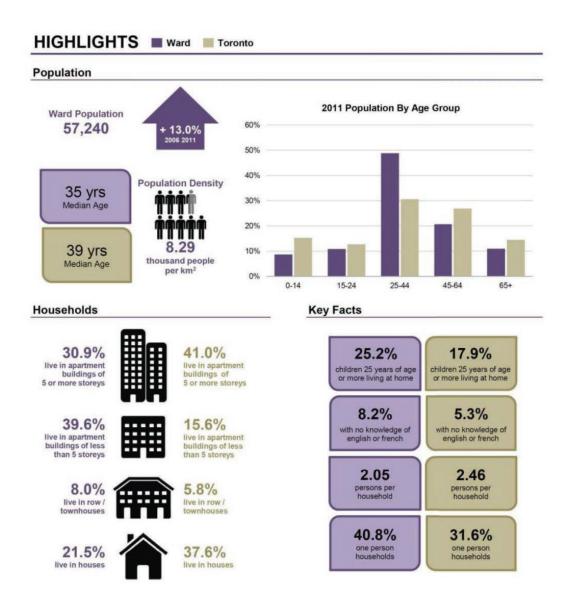

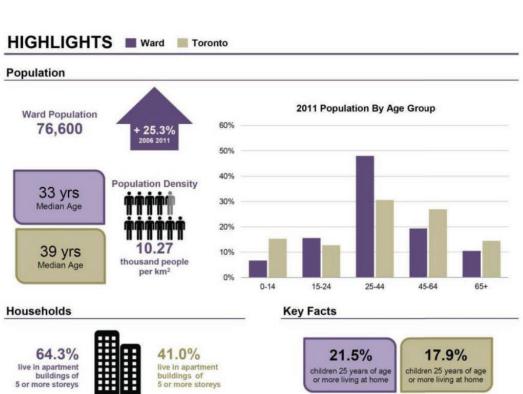


Ward 19 Profile

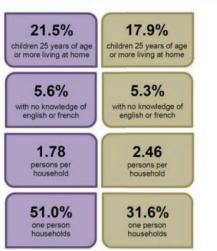




Ward 20 Profile

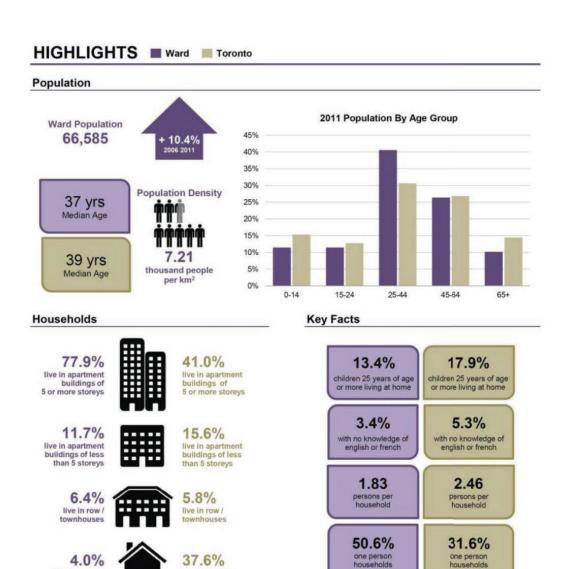








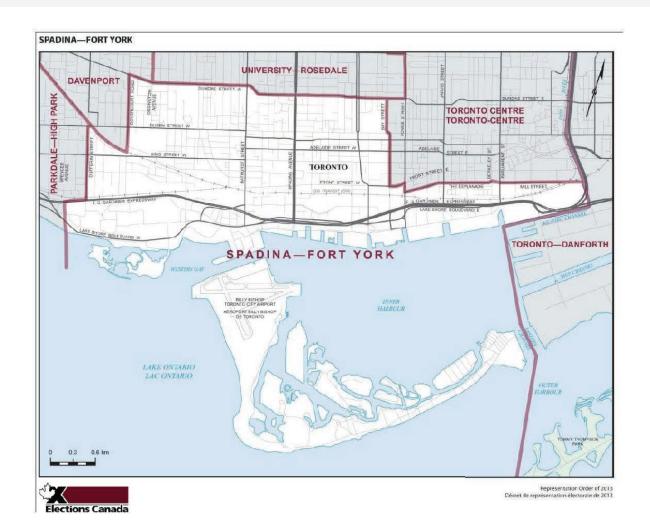
